NAHEP-CAAST

Centre for Advanced Agricultural Science and Technology (CAAST) is a new initiative and student centric sub-component of World Bank sponsored National Agricultural Higher Education Project (NAHEP) implemented by the Education Division, Indian Council of Agricultural Research in India. The Navsari Agricultural University, Navsari, Gujarat was granted a CAAST project on “Establishment of Secondary Agriculture Unit for Skill development in Students and Farmers at NAU, Navsari”

BACKGROUND

Secondary Agriculture

The agriculture sector in India employs more than 50% of the country's population and contributes about 17-18% to the GDP. The country is also witnessing a shift from primary agriculture to secondary agriculture. The Secondary Agriculture includes “all practices and process which add value to primary agricultural commodities by using efficient technologies, market information and consumer preference”. The Secondary Agriculture sector has a major role to play in employment generation, poverty alleviation and product diversification. It can reduce post harvest losses as well as those caused by glut in the market and thus increase the profitability in farming ventures. Secondary agriculture is one of the ways to achieve holistic and inclusive development of the farmers, forest dwellers and cattle owners. The Government of India and Indian Council of Agricultural Research has time and again emphasized the importance of skill development vocational training in students of agriculture and allied fields. It is in this context that CAAST-NAU is organizing a 15 days Skill Development Course on Secondary Agriculture at NAU, Navsari from March 20-April 3, 2019.

OBJECTIVES

- To Educate participants about the Importance, Scope and Role of Secondary Agriculture in India
- To Provide Hands on training to participants in different aspects of Secondary Agriculture

- To Provide exposure to participants to Public and Private Sector units involved in Secondary Agriculture
- To Acquaint participants of the Recent Advances in Secondary Agriculture

COURSE CONTENT

Secondary Agriculture includes all practices and processes which add value to primary agricultural commodities by using efficient technologies, market information and consumer preference. It is often regarded as a sunrise sector of Indian economy owing to its immense untapped potential. This training will broadly cover diverse topics related to Secondary Agriculture viz.

- Processing and Value Addition in Horticultural Crops
- Waste Utilization in Horticultural Produce and Dairying
- Scientific Utilization of Non-Timber Forest Products and Medicinal and Aromatic Plants
- Handling and Management of Dairy Units
- Pesticide Residue Analysis

DURATION

This is a 15 days residential training program which includes interactive lectures, hands-on training, demonstrations and exposure visits.

ELIGIBILITY

Post graduates from Agriculture/Forestry/Veterinary Sciences/Horticulture faculties of Navsari Agricultural University and/or admitted in the fourth semester onwards are eligible for this training program. Currently enrolled students have to submit an NOC from their Major Advisor along with the registration form which would be available in the circular section of www.nau.in. The candidate should have scored at least 60% marks in any of the above degrees. There are 25 seats available in this course which will be distributed among the above mentioned faculties.

REGISTRATION FEES

There is no registration fee for the training course. This training course is fully funded by NAHEP-CAAST.
