ANNEXURE I [Appendix 50.34(i)]

Guidelines for Assessing Academic Performance of Undergraduate Students for Gold Medal Awards at NAU:

1. Students achieving a minimum OGPA of 7.5 or higher will be considered eligible for various gold medals **except sports medals**. A list of these eligible students shall be compiled for further evaluation.
2. From the list of eligible candidates, the Dean of the respective faculty will create a merit list, giving 80% weightage to external marks and 20% weightage to internal marks, in consultation with the Academic Branch at the Registrar's Office, NAU, Navsari. This evaluation will encompass subjects taught up to the sixth semester, while the marks from the seventh and eighth semesters will be considered directly with a 50% weightage.

3. In the case of practical courses, internal marks will be treated as equivalent to external marks for the purpose of preparing the merit list.
4. The Dean of the concerned faculty should follow the following procedure for the preparation of the merit list of eligible candidates:

5. This merit list, along with all necessary documents, must be submitted to the scrutiny committee for the final decision of the recipients of various undergraduate level gold medals.



6. For medals awarded in individual subjects to the highest-scoring students, the following procedure will be implemented to identify the best student, as outlined in Serial No. 4:

Total marks up to two decimal should be prepared			

7. The scrutiny committee will assess the best-performing students for the award of gold medals, adhering to the rules and regulations specific to each medal. Academic performance will be evaluated based on the marks obtained through the aforementioned procedure for all gold medals.



ANNEXURE II [Appendix 50.34(i)]

Guidelines for Evaluating Academic Performance of Postgraduate Students for Gold Medal Awards at NAU:

1. Postgraduate students achieving an OGPA of 7.5 or higher will be eligible for consideration for various gold medals. Only the list of these qualified students will be utilized for subsequent evaluation.
2. From the aforementioned pool of eligible candidates, the Dean of the relevant faculty will formulate a merit list, allocating 80% weightage to external marks and 20% weightage to internal marks, in consultation with the Academic Branch at the Registrar's Office, NAU, Navsari.

3. In instances involving solely practical courses, internal marks will be treated as equivalent to external marks for the compilation of the merit list.
4. The Dean of the concerned faculty should adhere to the subsequent procedure for preparing the merit list of eligible candidates:

5. The list of candidates, accompanied by all necessary documents, shall be submitted to the scrutiny committee for the final decision of recipients of various postgraduate-level gold medals.
6. The scrutiny committee will assess the most outstanding students for the award of gold medals in accordance with the rules and regulations specific to each medal. The assessment of academic performance will be based on the marks obtained through the above-mentioned procedure for all gold medals.
