STUDENT ADMITTANCE NOTICE FOR THE YEAR 2019-2020 IN NAHEP-CAAST SUB-PROJECT

Navsari Agricultural University, Navsari has bagged a prestigious competitive grant under National Agricultural Higher Education Project funded by Govt. of India and World Bank for implementing a CAAST sub-project entitled "Establishment of Secondary Agriculture Unit for Skill Development in Students and Farmers at NAU, Navsari".

Objectives of CAAST project are

- To acquaint PG students with latest technologies in different spheres of secondary agriculture utilizing national and international expertise
- To develop technologies for processing and waste utilization in agriculture and allied fields, analytical techniques and its commercialization to private companies, budding entrepreneurs and agro-industries through strengthening of facilities and infrastructure

Terms and Conditions:

- 1. Post graduates from Agriculture / Forestry / Veterinary Sciences / Horticulture faculties are eligible for admittance in CAAST sub-project on Secondary Agriculture.
- 2. Students enrolled in departments (column III) mentioned for each thematic area (column I) would be preferred provided they are eligible for selection. Only if seats remain vacant in a specific thematic area/department that students from other disciplines of that faculty will be considered for selection.
- 3. Five M.Sc. students and Three Ph.D. students from each thematic area would be selected for participation in CAAST related activities.
- 4. M.Sc. and Ph.D. students admitted in 2019 with a CGPA of 7.0 and above in their graduation or post graduation are eligible for applying in CAAST sub-project.
- 5. Overall, 33.33 per cent of the positions would be reserved for girl students. In case, the girls' enrollment is overriding boys, due representation would be provided to boys. In case of non-

- availability of eligible students, the reserved seats for gender may be interchanged so that positions are not wasted.
- 6. Eligible student should have minimum 75% attendance in all the subjects.
- 7. Selected students will be a part of CAAST till the submission of their thesis.
- 8. Selected students can be discontinued from CAAST owing to indiscipline/misbehavior/lack of attendance or if they cause damage to the property during the training or research programme at any time by issue of one week's notice. At the end of the training period, the appointee has no right to claim any employment or engagement in NAU.
- 9. Selected students will be governed by Common PG Rules and Regulations of SAUs in Gujarat.
- 10. Both Master's and Ph.D. students admitted in CAAST sub-project would be eligible for international training.
- 11. For international training, managing a visa and passport would be sole responsibility of the selected P.G. students.
- 12. No TA, DA will be paid for appearing in the exam/group discussion and attending the interview.
- 13. The applicant must bring with them original documents and one set of photocopy of related documents/testimonials at the time of interview, failing which he/she shall not be allowed to appear the interview.
- 14. Students selected after the due process shall have to submit a Letter of Undertaking (LoU) stating that he/she shall participate in most of the CAAST activities and a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the major guide stating that he/she no objection to the participation of his/her student in CAAST activities would have to be submitted at the time of joining failing which, the Waiting List would become operational. The format for LoU and NoC would be provided to students at the time of joining.
- 15. Canvassing in any form will lead to cancellation of candidature.
- 16. Interview committee reserves all rights to reject any or all candidates.

- Interested PG students can submit their application by post/hand in the prescribed format (Annexure-II) along with copies of relevant certificates which should reach office address on or before dt. 10/10/2019. - "Application for Participation in NAHEP-CAAST Sub-Project" should be mentioned on the envelope.
- List of eligible and non-eligible PG students will be declared on the university website after due scrutiny on 14.10.2019.
- Eligible PG students will have to appear in a written exam on 16.10.2019. Group Discussion and Personal Interview will be held during October 18-19, 2019. The time and venue of the exam, group discussion and personal interview will be indicated on 14.10.2019 along with the eligibility list.
