

Programme:

The competitive events will be conducted on **4-12-2024** and valedictory function will be on **5-12-2024**. Participation as well as first three positions will be awarded with certificates. Only the winner team will be awarded with certificates in Round robin event.

General Guidelines for various Capacity Building Events:

General rules:

- There will be separate competition for UG/PG and polytechnic level.
- Six participants per college is allowed irrespective of UG/PG.
- The team will have to report at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time at venue.
- Participants are not allowed to use mobile or any ready-made resources.
- The decision of the judges will be final in each competition.
- Reporting and refreshment time will be 8.00 to 9.00 am.
- The detailed programme schedule will be communicated later on.

Quiz:

- There will be screening for participants.
- The quiz competition will contain two rounds namely oral questions and Audio-visual through Fastest Finger first round.

Poster making:

- The time allowed for poster making is 2 hours and the poster should be made in Chart Paper Size (56 cm x 38 cm) in horizontal layout.
- Paper will be provided to the participants by host and rest of the materials required for poster making such as poster/pastel/water colour, charcoal, sketch pen, pen, pencil, rubber, scale, compass *etc.* should bring by the participants.
- Concept, neatness, message/slogan disseminated through the poster will be taken into consideration.

Scitoon:

- The time allowed for Scitoon (Science-Cartoon) making is 1 hour and the Scitoon should be made in Chart Paper Size (56 cm x 38 cm) in horizontal layout.
- Other guidelines are as per poster making competition.

Still model:

- There is no limit of participants in this competition.
- One participant can submit only one model.
- The model may be judged on criteria such as design, fabrication, theme covered and explanation.
- Participant have to prepare model at own and submit on event date and time.
- Cost on preparation of model will be bear by participant.

Round robin:

- It is a team wise brain storming game only for **PG students** to find out logical solution for allotted problem.
- The problem, rules and guidelines will be provided at the time of event.
