Objective:

- To build students' capacity and raise awareness about healthy soil, healthy life and healthy cities through various competitive events.

Last date:

Send the details of nominated student participants from respective colleges/ polytechnic *via* email nauchempgseminar@gmail.com on or before **November 25, 2025**.

Programme:

The competitive events will be conducted on **5-12-2025** and prizes will be distributed on the same day. Participation as well as first three positions will be awarded with certificates. Only the winner team will be awarded with certificates in Mnemonic brain storming game.

General Guidelines for various Capacity Building Events:

- There will be separate competition for UG, PG and polytechnic level.
- The participant/team will have to report at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time at venue.
- Participants are not allowed to use mobile or any ready-made resources.
- The decision of the judges will be final in each competition.
- Reporting and refreshment time will be 8.00 to 9.00 am.
- The detailed programme schedule will be communicated later on.
- If any dispute arises during the events, the discission of the conveners of the organizing team will be stand final.

Quiz:

- The quiz will be conducted as team wise (three participants/team) separately **for UG, PG and polytechnic level**.
- The quiz competition will contain three rounds namely oral questions, Audio-visual round and rapid fire through Fastest Finger first.

Poster making:

- The time allowed for poster making is 2 hours and the poster should be made in Chart Paper Size (56 cm x 38 cm) in horizontal layout.
- Paper will be provided to the participants by host and rest of the materials required for poster making such as water colour, charcoal, sketch pen, pen, pencil, rubber, scale, compass *etc.* should bring by the participants.
- Concept, neatness, message/slogan disseminated through the poster will be taken into consideration.

Vegetable Carving

- The time allowed for vegetable carving is 2 hours and participants should bring their own carving tools, cutting boards, and vegetables/fruits and use of power tools (like dremels) are prohibited.
- The pre-preparation such as pre-slicing, carving, or drawing marks on the vegetables/fruits before the competition is not allowed.
- Artificial enhancements like wires, non-food-safe glues, artificial colouring and non-edible decorative elements (like artificial flowers or beads) are not allowed.
- External supports such as external bases like styrofoam or non-edible containers (bowls, vases) for the main sculpture are prohibited and the base should be edible or a simple plate.
- The vegetable carving will be judged based on creativity, technical skill, utility as well as presentation.
- Cost on preparation of vegetable carving will be bear by participant.

Craft making: Best from waste

- One participant can present only one craft. Craft should be of any form *i.e.* poster, model, decorative items *etc.*
- Craft should be prepared only from agricultural waste (crop residues, seeds, dried weeds, flowers, leaves, sticks *etc.*) or second-hand materials (e.g., plastic bottles, newspapers, cardboard boxes, old CDs, broken daily life utensils, fabric scraps *etc.*).
- Participants have to prepare model at own and submit on event date and time.
- Participants should be prepared to give a brief explanation or presentation of their concept, the materials used, and the craft item's utility to the judges.
- Cost on preparation of craft will be bear by participant.

Mnemonic Brain storming game

- It is a team wise brain storming game only for **PG students (4 participants/team)** to find out logical solution for allotted problem.
- The logical question, rules and guidelines will be provided at the time of event.
