Day 1 - 10th November 2025

The first day of the NSS Special Camp began on 10th November 2025 with the inauguration ceremony held at *Vanchetna Kendra, Dandi*, managed by the Forest Department under the Chikhli Range. During the opening ceremony, the Chief Guest was the first citizen and *Sarpanch* of Dandi village, Mrs. Nikita Rathod. She warmly welcomed all NSS volunteers and staff to the village and assured complete cooperation from the villagers throughout the special camp. The day also included a brief introduction to the objectives and schedule of the NSS camp, marking a positive and motivating beginning to the week-long activities.

During the opening ceremony, Dr. M. P. Ahir, Principal of Horticulture Polytechnic, welcomed all the guests and encouraged the volunteers to participate actively in the camp. Dr. Kalubhai Dangar, Director of the Gandhi Project at Dandi, also shared his NSS experiences and motivated the volunteers with his inspiring words. Dr. Priyanka Patel, NSS Programme Officer, briefly explained the regular NSS activities and presented the plan for the special camp, guiding the volunteers for the days ahead.

The volunteers actively took part in a beach cleaning activity, where they collected plastic waste, bottles, wrappers, and other garbage scattered along the shoreline. They also cleaned the surrounding areas by removing *kachra* (waste/garbage) and unwanted materials to keep the environment neat and pollution-free. With teamwork and dedication, the volunteers helped restore the cleanliness and natural beauty of the beach, creating awareness about keeping public places clean. Along with the cleanliness drive, the volunteers also organized an awareness rally in *Dandi* village. Holding banners and slogans on cleanliness, environmental protection, and social responsibility, they marched through the main streets of the village. The rally inspired local residents to maintain hygiene, reduce plastic use, and take active participation in keeping their surroundings clean. Through their enthusiastic efforts, the volunteers successfully spread a strong message of “Clean Village, Green Village.”

In the afternoon session, Dr. H. M. Patel, Associate Professor, Horticulture Polytechnic, NAU Navsari, addressed the volunteers and delivered an informative session on soil and water management. He explained the importance of conserving water, adopting efficient irrigation methods, and maintaining soil health for sustainable agriculture. His guidance helped the volunteers gain valuable

knowledge about responsible resource management and its role in protecting the environment.

The session helped volunteers understand how mangroves act as natural barriers and play a crucial role in maintaining environmental balance. After the lecture, the volunteers organized an awareness rally in the *faliya/sheri*, spreading messages on mangrove protection, environmental responsibility, and community participation in conservation efforts.

MOTIVATIONAL SESSION UNDER NSS

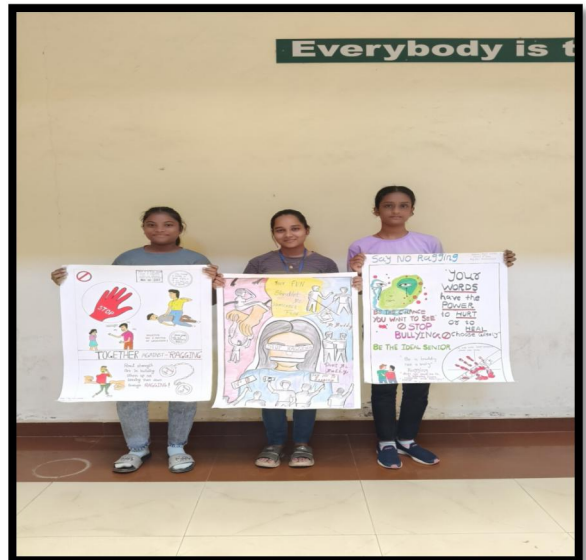

CPR AND THALASSEMIA AWARENESS PROGRAMME

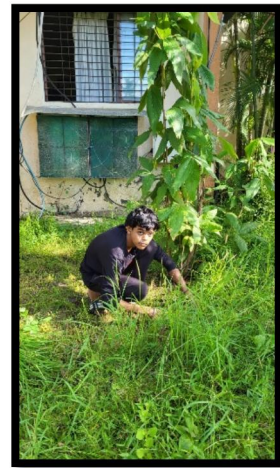

CYBER SECURITY, ONLINE FRAUD & TRAFFIC RULES AWARENESS PROGRAMME

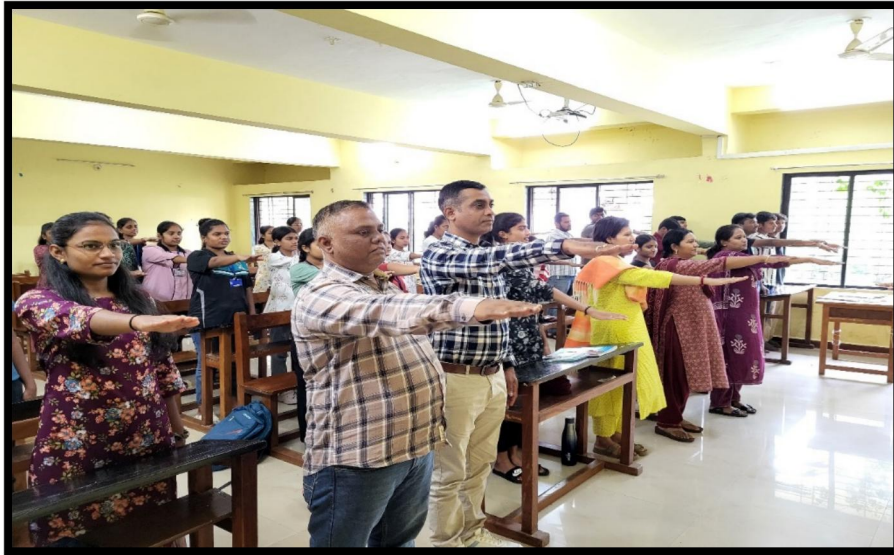

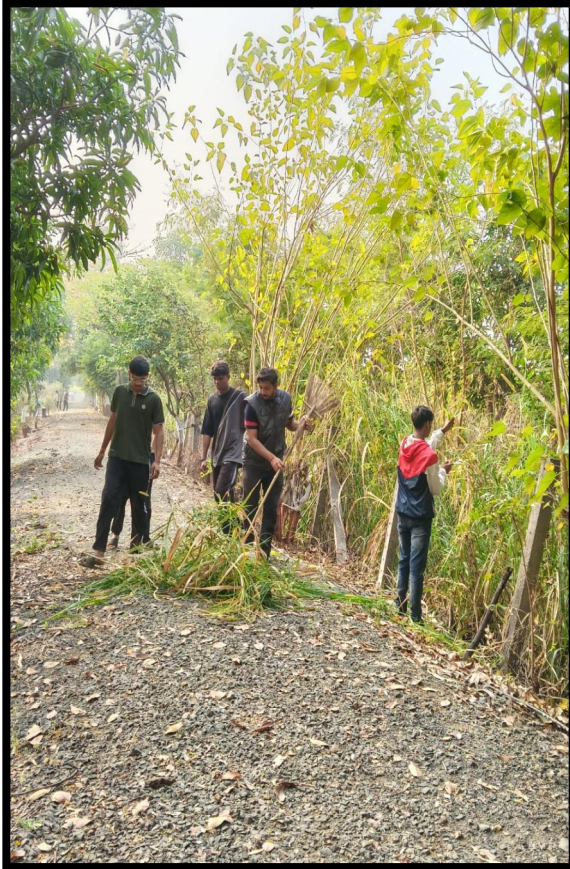

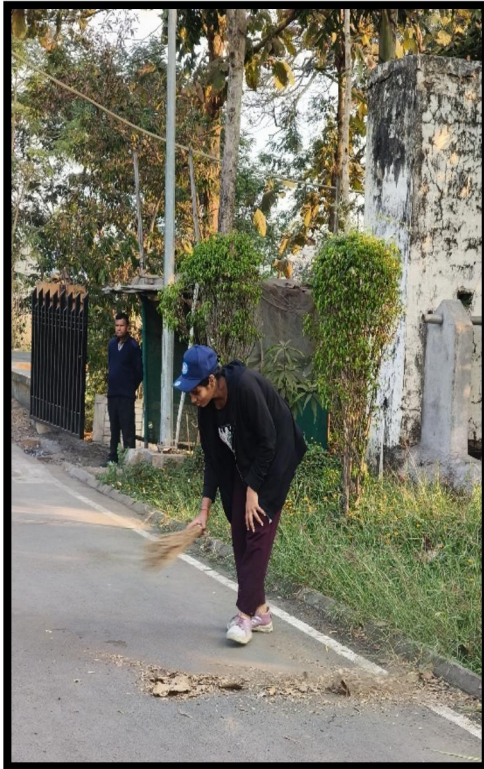
