RULES AND REGULATION FOR INTER COLLEGIATE LITERARY COMPETITION

Event wise rules & regulations are as below:

A. DEBATE

- Each college shall be represented by **two participants** only **one speaking in favour and one speaking against**.
- Each participating student shall be given 5 minutes to speak on the topic.
- Gujarati, Hindi, or English language can be used as medium of expression.
- There will be a warning bell at four minutes. The candidate has to conclude his/her speech in remaining one minute.
- Decision of the judge shall be final and binding upon all.

B. ELOCUTION

- Only **one participant per college** is allowed.
- Each participating student shall be given 5 minutes to speak on the topic. Gujarati, Hindi, or English language can be used as medium of expression.
- There will be a warning bell at four minutes. The candidate has to conclude his/her speech in remaining one minute.
- Decision of the judge shall be final and binding upon all.

C. EXTEMPORE SPEECH

- Only **one participant per college** is allowed.
- The topic shall be given on the spot.
- Each participating student shall be given 5 minutes to speak on the topic. Gujarati, Hindi, or English language can be used as medium of expression.
- There will be a warning bell at four minutes. The candidate has to conclude his/her speech in remaining one minute.
- Decision of the judge shall be final and binding upon all.
