


Regarding the rules and regulations to award "South Gujarat Koli Patel Agricultural Graduates Gold Plated Silver Medal"

ANNEXURE VI

Regulations for the award of “**South Gujarat Koli Patel Agricultural Graduates Gold Plated Silver Medal**” to the Undergraduate student of the **Agriculture faculty** of Navsari Agricultural University, Navsari

1. The Medal shall be called **“Koli Patel (S.G.) Agricultural Graduates Gold Plated Silver Medal”**
2. The annual realization of the total endowment of Rs. 8,20,000/- shall be credited to the general fund of the Navsari Agricultural University. From the total endowment, the interest earned on Rs.4,10,000/- (Rs. Four Lakhs Ten Thousand only) should be used to prepare a Silver Medal plated with Gold for Agriculture faculty.
3. The medal shall be awarded in the form of a Gold plated Silver Medal engraved with the words **“Koli Patel (S.G.) Agricultural Graduates Gold Plated Silver Medal”** along with a citation.
4. The Gold Plated Silver Medal (100g of silver and coated with gold) shall be prepared by Navsari Agricultural University, Navsari for B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture degree. The total cost of gold & silver and other charges for the medal shall be incurred from the interest of the fund provided by the donor to the esteemed University.
5. The medal shall be awarded to the best Undergraduate students of the **Agriculture faculty** of Navsari Agricultural University, Navsari.
6. The award shall be declared at the time of the Annual Convocation by the Board of Management on the recommendation of the Academic Council.
7. The medal shall be made to an Undergraduate student of the **Agriculture Faculty** whose overall performance in the study (O.G.P.A.) up to the final semester of degree course examination and extra-curricular activities like Sports, N.C.C., N.S.S., Essay, Debate, Cultural, Adventure activities *etc.* carried out by the university during his/her study (as per Appendix –I) judged to be the best at the Undergraduate level.
8. The assessment committee of Registrar, Director of Students' Welfare and Dean of concerned faculty will consider the cases of not more than the first ten highest (O.G.P.A.) marks scoring students in Agriculture faculty amongst the

colleges and shall submit the list of such candidates with full data to the Experts' Committee.

9. Dean/Principal of Agriculture faculty shall scrutinize the academic record of all the students whose names have been proposed for the award and determine marks obtained in OGPA which would have 60% and 40% weightage in form of extra-curricular/practical activities (Appendix -I).
10. The Vice Chancellor will appoint two persons as a member of the Experts' Committee, however, preference should be given to the representative amongst the donors (list attached herewith). The Registrar will act as a Member Secretary of the committee. The committee of experts shall judge the comparative merits of the candidates and shall select the best among them in each faculty.
11. The committee of experts shall judge the comparative merits of the candidates for Agriculture faculty among all colleges and shall select the best among them in Agriculture faculty.
12. A student shall not be eligible for the award of the medal if he/she (i) has less than 7.00 (O.G.P.A.) grade point or got (Fail) or 'US' or 'I' grade at any time in any course (ii) dropped the (Barring withdrawal) course as a regular student (iii) left the course incomplete or (iv) was on conduct probation for his / her misconduct/misbehavior during any semester of Undergraduate course.
13. The decision of the Board of Management in the matter of the award of medal shall be final.
14. In case of a tie, the student with the higher score in practical should be considered.
15. The endowment shall suitably be acknowledged by the Navsari Agricultural University on the occasion of the Annual Convocation.
16. The endowment shall suitably be incorporated in the Annual Report of Navsari Agricultural University.

ANNEXURE VII

Regulations for the award of “South Gujarat Koli Patel Agricultural Graduates Gold Plated Silver Medal” to the Undergraduate student of the **Horticulture faculty** of Navsari Agricultural University, Navsari

1. The Medal shall be called **“Koli Patel (S.G.) Agricultural Graduates Gold Plated Silver Medal”**
2. The annual realization of the total endowment of Rs. 8,20,000/- shall be credited to the general fund of the Navsari Agricultural University. From the total endowment, the interest earned on Rs.4,10,000/- (Rs. Four Lakhs Ten Thousand only) should be used to prepare a Silver Medal plated with Gold for Horticulture faculty.
3. The medal shall be awarded in the form of a Gold plated Silver Medal engraved with the words **“Koli Patel (S.G.) Agricultural Graduates Gold Plated Silver Medal”** along with a citation.
4. The Gold Plated Silver Medal (100g of silver and coated with gold) shall be prepared by Navsari Agricultural University, Navsari for B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture degree. The total cost of gold & silver and other charges for the medal shall be incurred from the interest of the fund provided by the donor to the esteemed University.
5. The medal shall be awarded to the best Undergraduate students of the **Horticulture faculty** of Navsari Agricultural University, Navsari.
6. The award shall be declared at the time of the Annual Convocation by the Board of Management on the recommendation of the Academic Council.
7. The medal shall be made to an Undergraduate student of the **Horticulture Faculty** whose overall performance in the study (O.G.P.A.) up to the final semester of degree course examination and extra-curricular activities like Sports, N.C.C., N.S.S., Essay, Debate, Cultural, Adventure activities *etc.* carried out by the university during his/her study (as per Appendix –I) judged to be the best at the Undergraduate level.
8. The assessment committee of Registrar, Director of Students' Welfare and Dean of concerned faculty will consider the cases of not more than the first ten

- highest (O.G.P.A.) marks scoring students in Horticulture faculty and shall submit the list of such candidates with full data to the Experts' Committee.
9. Dean/Principal of Horticulture faculty shall scrutinize the academic record of all the students whose names have been proposed for the award and determine marks obtained in OGPA which would have 60% and 40% weightage in form of extra-curricular/practical activities (Appendix -I).
 10. The Vice Chancellor will appoint two persons as a member of the Experts' Committee, however, preference should be given to the representative amongst the donors (list attached herewith). The Registrar will act as a Member Secretary of the committee. The committee of experts shall judge the comparative merits of the candidates and shall select the best among them.
 11. The committee of experts shall judge the comparative merits of the candidates for Horticulture faculty and shall select the best among them.
 12. A student shall not be eligible for the award of the medal if he/she (i) has less than 7.00 (O.G.P.A.) grade point or got (Fail) or 'US' or 'T' grade at any time in any course (ii) dropped the (Barring withdrawal) course as a regular student (iii) left the course incomplete or (iv) was on conduct probation for his / her misconduct/misbehavior during any semester of Undergraduate course.
 13. The decision of the Board of Management in the matter of the award of medal shall be final.
 14. In case of a tie, the student with the higher score in practical should be considered.
 15. The endowment shall suitably be acknowledged by the Navsari Agricultural University on the occasion of the Annual Convocation.
 16. The endowment shall suitably be incorporated in the Annual Report of Navsari Agricultural University.
