ANNEXURE - I

Revised rule and regulations for games and sports tournaments at Navsari Agricultural Universities

1.	Title of the Rules
	"Regulations governing Games, Sports, Cultural, Literary Competition / Tournaments and Adventure Activities of the Navsari Agricultural University"
1.1	These rules shall be called "Regulations governing Games, Sports Tournaments, Cultural, Literary Competition and Adventure Activities for Inter-college / Inter-polytechnic / Inter-university " of the Navsari Agricultural University.
1.2	They shall come into force from the date of Notification.
2.	Definition
2.1	In these rules, unless the context otherwise require, SPORTS means an activity that is governed by a set of rules or customs and often engaged in competitively. Sports commonly refers to activities where the physical capabilities of the competitor are the sole or primary determinant of the outcome (winning or losing), but the term is also used to include activities such as mind sports and motor sports where mental acuity or equipment quality are major factors. Sport is commonly defined as an organized, competitive and skillful physical activity requiring commitment and fair play.
2.2	PLAYER/PARTICIPANT means one that plays/performs, especially one who participates in Games, Sports Tournaments, Cultural, Literary Competition and Adventure Activities of the State Agricultural University.
2.3	TOURNAMENT means a sporting competition in which contestants play a series of games to determine an overall winner.
2.4	INTER-COLLEGIATE means competition taking place among different colleges (degree and polytechnic) of the university of the state.
2.5	INTER-UNIVERSITY means competition taking place among different Universities of the state or the country.
2.6	COLLEGE means a constituent college conducting degree or polytechnic programme in the state Agricultural Universities.
2.7	SPORTS COMMITTEE means a committee of the Student Sports and Recreation. The Committee has to develop and implement strategies and policies to develop, encourage and coordinate sports activities across the institute.
2.8	REFEREE/ JUDGE means a person who has authority to make decisions about play/performances in many sports/competitions.
2.9	COMPETITION means an official participation in organized sport.
2.10	TEAM means a number of persons associated together in any sports; especially, a number of persons selected to contend on one side in a match, or a series of matches.
3.	Sports Committee
3.1	There shall be a committee consisting of the following to organize, control, manage and supervise various competitions/tournaments and students' welfare programme within the jurisdiction of the university and conduct inter-university sports tournament/competition. i. Director of Students' Welfare-Chairman ii. Chairman of the Students' Representative Council of all the constituent Colleges -Member iii. Physical Instructors of all the constituent Colleges -Member
4.	The powers and functions of the sports committee shall be as follows:
4.1	To prepare its programme calendar, various games, sports, cultural and literary events, adventure programmes and its budget for presentation to the University.
4.2	To decide University should participate in the several inter-university games and sports competitions.

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4.3	To appoint sub-committee if necessary, to select university team and to conduct inter-university games and sports competitions whenever the University is asked to do so by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), Inter Agricultural Universities Association (IAUA) or Council of State Agricultural Universities of Gujarat.
4.4	To frame eligibility rules and general rules for sports and games, debate, extempore, essay, cultural competitions and other adventure programmes.
4.5	To settle dispute if any, among constituent colleges with regard to tournaments / competitions and other student activities within the jurisdiction of the sports committee.
4.6	To take up such other programmes and activities within the jurisdiction of the sports committee as desired for the welfare of the students.
5.	Inter-collegiate / Inter-polytechnic Sports and Games Tournaments / Competitions
5.1	The method of the various tournaments / competitions shall be decided by the Committee.
5.2	All the colleges/polytechnics shall inform the organizing college/polytechnic regarding their participation and shall submit the eligibility pro forma of the players before the commencement of the tournaments / competitions.
5.3	A lots of the tournaments / competitions will be drawn in presence of all team managers and organizing secretary.
5.4	The Sports Committee shall allocate the responsibility to conduct the tournament / competition to any constituent college.
5.5	The organizing college/polytechnic shall be responsible for its organization, supervision and conduct of the tournament / competition for this purpose. If required, the Principal of the organizing college/polytechnic shall appoint various committees. The Chairman, Students' Representative Council shall be the organizing secretary. However, the overall responsibility of organizing the tournament / competition shall be of the Director of Students' Welfare and he/she may delegate his/her power to anyone to whom he/she deems fit wishes to. The organizing secretary shall draw the detailed programme of the inter-college/polytechnic tournament / competition and send it to all participating colleges/polytechnics under intimation to the chairman, sports committee.
5.6	It shall be the duty of organizing committee to ensure that all the rules and regulations laid down by the sports committee for the inter- college/polytechnic tournaments /competitions are fully observed and game/tournament/competition is played fairly. In case, where a particular team has included ineligible player, as defined in the rules, the team shall be disqualified from the tournament after due verification. In case of the misconduct by any individual player(s) or a team as a whole, the organizing committee shall have power even to scratch the team/disqualify the individual player(s) from the tournament/competition. While doing so, whoever, the organizing committee shall strictly follow the procedure as laid down below: (a) Both the teams under dispute are given full opportunities to explain their respective points of view. (b) The Principal of the organizing college/polytechnic shall constitute committee of (1) Organizing Secretary (2) Physical Instructor (3) One expert of the game (c) The matter is reported immediately to the Chairman, Sports Committee for information and further action if any.
5.7	The organizing college/polytechnic shall appoint the referee/ official/judge in concern with Director of Students' Welfare and they are entitled to get T.A. and D.A. as per the rates mentioned in the Appendix-I.
5.8	It shall be duty of the Organizing Secretary to inform the Chairman, Sports Committee regarding the date of tournament/competition. The result of the tournament/competition along with eligibility pro forma and list of the selected players of the university team shall be submitted to the Chairman, Sports Committee. Also to communicate the result to all the colleges on the next day.

5.9	Each constituent college/ polytechnic shall be entitled to send only one team for each tournament/ competition. Minimum Three College shall participate to conduct the team / individual tournament/ competition.																																														
5.10	The rules and regulations of the sports and games will be followed as framed by the concerned Association/Federation of the sports and games.																																														
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5.11	Sports committee is empowered to add or delete any game/sport/event and number of participants. If less than three teams are participating in the team event tournament/competition, the same tournament/competition shall not be organized. In individual event like Athletic, if there are less than three competitors, the competition shall not be organized.																																														
5.12	There shall be no entry fees for participation in inter college / polytechnic tournaments/competitions.																																														
5.13	Each college/polytechnic entering a tournament/competition shall supply necessary information prescribed by the Sports Committee to the Organizing Secretary.																																														
5.14	Eligibility rules for participants as per rules prescribed by the AIU/IAUA/ICAR/NAU from time to time. A student shall not compete on behalf of more than one college/polytechnic in any Inter-Collegiate/Inter-Polytechnic tournaments/competition in a year.																																														
5.15	<p>For the Intercollegiate / Inter-Polytechnic Athletic event, each college / polytechnic may send maximum two competitors for each Athletic event and one team for relay races, the total, however not to exceed 15 in Men & 10 in Women competitors. In Athletics, no student can participate in more than five events excluding relay races for Individual General Championship. Player should have taken part in any 5 events (2 running events and 3 field events or 3 running events and 2 field events, relay shall not be considered). 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	<p>Following Athletic events shall be played for Intercollegiate / Inter-Polytechnic Athletic competition. 5.16	All participant in Intercollege/polytechnic tournaments/competitions shall carry with them identity cards signed by the Principal of the college concerned.

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5.19	If the match is not played due to any sound reasons like rain etc., it shall be played as per the rules of a particular game.																																																
5.20	Protest against the decision of referee/umpire/judge or any other matter shall be lodged in writing within two hours of conclusion of the game/competition and depositing Rs.2000/- to the person in charge of the organizing college/polytechnic.																																																
5.21	If the protest is lodged prior to or during match, the match shall be played out. Teams, which abandon a match for any reason, shall be considered to have concerned it. Any team leaving field of play under protest shall be deemed to have loss the fixture and forfeited whenever a protest is not sustained. The Organizing Secretary shall send a report of any such incident to the Chairman, Sports Committee.																																																

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5.22	The Organizing College shall arrange intercollege / inter-polytechnic level tournaments / competitions expenditures like refreshment, trophies, banner, rent of sound system / light / ground / bedding materials/ mandap & samiyana, purchase of flower bouquet/ book/ memento/ stationary, officiating charges (remuneration, DA and TA), equipment (purchase/ rent), expenses for ground preparation, purchase of Winners and Runners-up trophies & certificates, other charges, etc. from budget provision by Director Students' Welfare and college / polytechnic own funds.
5.23	In Team Event certificate shall be provided to winners and runners up team and In solo Event certificate shall be awarded to First, Second and Third position holder by organizing college/polytechnic. The participation certificate shall be prepared by respective college/polytechnic. In Team event trophy awarded to winner and runners up team only. In Solo event trophy/medal awarded to first, second and third position holder by organizing college/polytechnic.
5.24	Expenses on account of refreshment, official charges, ground preparation hiring of grounds and such other items pertaining to pay-fields shall be borne by the University as per the budget provision.
5.25	The University shall bear total cost of the second class rail/bus fare with reservation charges of players other than local players from the place of the college/polytechnic to the place of tournament and back, if transportation arrangement is made by the college/polytechnic, the university shall bear the total diesel/ oil expenditure.
5.26	The University shall bear total cost of the D.A. of student participants. (i) Student participants of out-station college/polytechnic shall be paid D.A. at the rate of Rs.300/-per day each. (ii) Student participants of local college/polytechnic shall be paid the refreshment/convenience allowance at the rate of Rs.200/- per day. If the tournament is conducted during the vacation, the participating players are entitled to get full D.A. and T.A. from the place of native to the place of tournament and back.
5.27	The university shall bear the expenses (Honorarium/Remuneration/T.A/D.A) on account of the allowances to the official of various tournaments shall be paid as per Appendix-I.
5.28	The university shall bear the cost of Rs. 700/- per participant as dress allowance for each intercollegiate/inter-polytechnic Sports tournament.
6.	Intercollegiate / Inter-polytechnic Cultural and Literary Competition
	a) Any student enrolled in the constituent college/polytechnic of the university shall be eligible to participate in this competition. The eligibility rules for the competition shall be same as the rules for the Sports and Games.
	b) All the participants are entitled to get T.A. and D.A. for participation in the competition as decided for the inter-collegiate / inter polytechnic Sports and Games tournaments.
	c) The university shall bear the cost of Rs. 700/- per participant as dress allowance for each intercollegiate/inter-polytechnic Literary Competition. For Cultural Competitions Expenses of Costumes, Makeup and Properties <i>etc.</i> , shall be bear by participant colleges/polytechnics.
	d) The expenditure for organizing the competition such as refreshment, officiating charges, prizes <i>etc.</i> shall be paid from the university fund allotted for the purpose.
	e) The organizing college/polytechnic shall appoint the judging committee of two/ three members in concern with Director of Students' Welfare and they are entitled to get T.A. and D.A. as per the rates mentioned in the Appendix-I.
	f) Overall aggregate score of judging committee shall be considered to find out the winners of Intercollegiate / Inter-polytechnic Cultural and Literary Competition as per Appendix – II & III.

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	g) The decision of the judging committee shall be final.																								
	h) Participating college/polytechnic shall submit the details of all entries to the organizing college before 5 days of event.																								
	i) General guidelines regarding all events shall be as decided by the Sports/cultural Committee which is also empowered to add or delete any event and number of participants.																								
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6.1	Cultural Competitions																								
	a) There shall be separate competitions for Folk Dance, Drama (One Act Play), Mime and Mono Acting.																								
	b) Each college/polytechnic shall send one entry for Drama (One Act Play), Folk Dance and Mime and two entries for Mono-Acting.																								
	c) Total number of participants for Cultural Competitions from a college/polytechnic shall not be more than 30 (27 participant + 03 accompanists)																								
	d) The Number of Participants and duration of cultural competitions is as follow:

	e) The first prize winning events should not be performed by winner college/polytechnic for the subsequent three years.																								
	f) Expenses on account of refreshment, official charges, stage preparation, and such other items pertaining to tournament shall be borne by the University.																								
6.2	Literary Competitions

	The organizing college/polytechnic is empowered to decide the topic for the competition in concern with Director of Students' Welfare. Topic of the debate shall be announced well in advance i.e., at least 15 days before date of competition.																								
	The participating students should be given five (5) minutes to speak on the topic.																								
	Any form of written matter as aid shall not be allowed. Violation shall be liable for disqualification.																								
6.2.2	Extempore Speech Competition																								
	The organizing college/polytechnic is empowered to decide the topic for the competition in concern with Director of Students' Welfare.																								
	The participating students shall get the topic on the spot at a time of competition and shall be given five (5) minutes for preparation and five (5) minutes to speak on the topic.																								

6.2.3	Elocution Competition												
	The organizing college/polytechnic is empowered to decide the topic for the competition in concern with Director of Students' Welfare. Topic of the elocution shall be announced well in advance <i>i.e.</i> , at least before 10 days.												
	The participating students should be given five (5) minutes to speak on the topic.												
	Any form of written matter as aid shall not be allowed. Violation shall be liable for disqualification.												
6.4	There shall be an Overall Champion and Runners up Trophy in Cultural and Literary Competition which shall be awarded to the college / polytechnic obtaining the highest aggregate points on basis of the scoring system given below:

7	Inter-University Tournaments/Competitions												
7.1	The University may participate in the Inter-University tournaments / competitions / Yuva Mahotsav / Khel Mahakumbh / West Zone & AIU tournaments etc. as may be decided by the Sports Committee.												
7.2	The selection of the university team or participants shall be made on the basis of performance in the inter-collegiate / inter polytechnic tournaments/competitions.												
7.3	The selection committee for the selection of university team shall be as under : (i) Physical Instructor/s (ii) Chief Referees If the teams/participants are not selected by selection committee, the Chairman, Sports Committee is empowered to select the same to represent the university.												
7.4	The Chairman, Sports Committee may assign any staff member as team manager who will be overall responsible for the participation in the tournament/competition.												
7.5	The annual subscription for the membership of the AIU/ICAR/IAUA/other concerned association shall be paid by the university every year. The entry fee, match fee, other administrative fees/charges of the inter-university events should be borne by University.												
7.6	The University shall bear the cost of Rs. 1,000/- per participant as dress allowance for each sports tournament and Literary Competition. For Cultural Competitions Expenses of Costumes, Makeup and Properties <i>etc.</i> , shall be bear by participant colleges/polytechnics.												
7.7	The university shall bear the expenditure for track-suit of maximum cost of Rs. 3,000/- per participants and Team Manager. The track-suit shall be given to the player only once in one degree programme at the university. The track-suit shall be given to Team Manager with an interval of 3 years.												
7.8	The university shall bear the second class railway fare with reservation/ state or private bus (non-AC sitting/ sleeper and AC Sitting as per ticket availability and venue of tournament) or taxi/ rickshaw traveling charges or the diesel, oil, R.T.O/ toll taxes, expenses of the university vehicles. Due to some reason, if confirm ticket is not available in railway at a time of booking, then railway <i>Tatkal</i> / Premium <i>Tatkal</i> tickets may be booked in second class, sleeper or III-tier AC tickets may be booked in special case. In a special case, a private vehicle may be hired for transportation with prior permission of competent authority of University.												
7.9	(i) The participant is entitled to get the Daily Allowance (D.A.) of ₹ 500/- per day for the tournament/ competition conducted outside the State and ₹ 400/- per day for the tournament/ competition conducted within the State. (ii) If food/accommodation/transportation other charges are fixed by the organizing university (host), the cost of the same for the players should be borne by University.												

7.10	<p>The university will provide travel allowance (T.A.) and daily allowance (D.A.) to the player/ participant of the university team during Training/ coaching camp as per the rules as below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. The University shall bear T.A. of total cost for the second class railway/ government or private bus fare (non-AC and sitting) with reservation charges of player other than local player from the place of their college/ polytechnic to the place of coaching camp and back to their college/ polytechnic. ii. The University shall bear total cost of the D.A. for participant as under. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Participant of Out-station College / polytechnic should get D.A. of ₹ 250/- per day. b) Participant of local college/ polytechnic should get refreshment/ convenience allowance of ₹ 150/- per day. c) If the tournament is conducted during the vacation, all the participating players are entitled to get full D.A. and T.A. from the place of native to the place of tournament and back as per the rate shown in (i) & (ii) (a) and (b) above.
7.11	The university shall provide the equipment, ground facility <i>etc.</i> required for coaching camp.
7.12	The university shall bear the cost for the organizing university level tournaments/ competitions expenditures like refreshment, banner, rent of sound system/ light system/ ground/ bedding materials/ <i>mandap & shamiyana</i> , purchase of flower bouquet/ book/ memento/ stationary, officiating charges (remuneration, D.A. and T.A.), equipment (purchase/ rent), expenses for ground preparation, purchase of Winners and Runners-up trophies & certificates, other charges, <i>etc.</i>
7.13	University may appoint a coach for advance training/Coaching to the university team. He / She shall be entitled to get T.A. and D.A. as well as Honorarium as per rules for the officials of inter-collegiate/inter-polytechnic tournament/competition.
7.14	The attendance of players/participants in the advanced training/coaching camps is compulsory (100 per cent mandatory). The Director of Students' Welfare, NAU may grant relaxation to players/participants based on prior approval with a genuine reason.
7.15	Petty expenditure for refreshing item such as glucose, lemon, ice-cream, biscuit, fruit and first aid kit <i>etc.</i> , will be borne by the university.
7.16	In case of sickness or physical injury to the player/participant during the actual game/competition/coaching/training camp at the time of inter-college/inter-polytechnic and inter-university/All India competition, the cost of medical treatment of the player/participant shall be borne by the University.
7.17	The winning team shall be offered a complimentary lunch/dinner within a limit of the maximum rate for a deluxe dish fixed at the Guest House of our university. The expenditure for the same should be borne by the DSW office, NAU.
8	Adventure Activities
8.1	The students of constituent colleges/ polytechnics may take part in the adventure activities.
8.2	The students of constituent colleges/ polytechnics for basic rock climbing camp should be selected on the basis of physical fitness, participation in extra-curricular activity, grade points and if required then based on 1600 meter running in Six (06) minutes and Twenty (20) seconds for the boys and 800 meter running in Four (04) minutes and Ten (10) seconds for the girls.
8.3	The selected students shall be entitled to get bus/second class railway fare from college/ polytechnic to the place of camp and return back to college/ polytechnic as per available of grant/fund from college/ polytechnic/ university.



8.4	The students shall be paid D.A. as per rules of Inter-university tournament/ competition.
8.5	If the lodging and boarding arrangements are made by the organizer, the total cost of the expenditure shall be borne by the university.
8.6	The Chairman, Sports Committee will decide numbers of participants from each college/ polytechnic on the basis of seats availability.
8.7	A team manager shall be appointed to look after the monitoring, administrative and account matter.
8.8	The adventure programs which are approved or conducted by the government agencies shall be undertaken.
8.9	The students of constituent colleges/ polytechnics may take part in the advanced rock climbing camp as per selection procedure and final decision of Chairman, Sports Committee.
9.	Disciplinary Rules of Tournament/ Competition
	<p>Indiscipline, Misbehavior and Violations of Rules& Regulations of university. Students' misbehaviour including different range of actions, both on and off the field, such as:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Verbal abuse: Using offensive, abusive, or vulgar language towards opponents, officials, coaches or spectators. 2. Physical violence: Intentionally using physical force to hurt, injure, or control another participant/person, aggressive behaviour or fighting with anyone during the competition. 3. Disruptive conduct: Intentionally disrupting the game/event, such as arguing excessively with officials or causing delays. 4. Lack of sportsmanship: Displaying un-sportsmanship like conduct, cheating or intentionally breaking the rules of the game/event. 5. Vandalism: Damaging sports equipment, facilities or property. 6. Consumption of prohibited substances: Using alcohol, drugs, or other intoxicants on the ground/at event venue/at university premise. <p>Actions and penalties against indiscipline, misbehaviors and violations</p> <p>The consequences for misbehaviour vary depending on the severity of the offense and are handled by the organizing committee, which often includes the tournament/competition's organizing secretary, physical instructors and referees/judges during Inter-college/ Inter-polytechnic / Inter University Competition. Penalties can range from on-the-spot actions to more severe, long-term consequences.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. On-the-spot penalties by referee/ judge: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Warning: The referee/ judge may issue a verbal warning to the player or team. b) Foul or Penalty: A technical foul or penalty may be awarded to the opposing team. c) Player Ejection: An individual player may be disqualified from the specific match or event. d) Team Disqualification: The entire team may be disqualified from the tournament. 2. Long-term consequences: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Debarment: The individual player or the entire team may be debarred from participating in future tournaments for a specified period (e.g., one year or more).

	<p>b) Official Report: The incident to be reported formally by organizing secretary of respective college/ polytechnic to the Chairman, Sports Committee of University at Inter-college / polytechnic tournament/competition. However, for Inter university tournament/competition, the incident to be reported to the respective university's sports committee and administration.</p> <p>c) Financial Penalties: Fines may be levied on the college/polytechnic/university or team for damages caused or as a penalty for indiscipline.</p> <p>d) Academic Impact: In some cases, extreme misbehaviour may lead to disciplinary action at the university level, which could affect the student's academic standing.</p> <p>The Chairman, Sports Committee is empowered to take final decision for above disciplinary actions against the participating or non-participating individual or team which liable to all as per university's disciplinary rules and regulations with concerned to university authorities.</p>
10.	Miscellaneous
10.1	All participating students must submit a signed undertaking acknowledging that they will abide by the rules of the Sports Committee and are physically fit to participate. The undertaking shall indemnify the College/ Polytechnic/ University against liability for non-negligent injury or loss incurred during training and competition. (Annexure-IV)
10.2	A mandatory undertaking form must be submitted to the Organizing Secretary/ The Chairman, Sports Committee before any student is cleared for participation in official events. This document confirms the student's consent, commitment to disciplinary conduct and acceptance of all inherent risks. (Annexure-IV)
11.	Decision powers render to Chairman, Sports Committee
11.1	The Chairman, Sports Committee, is authorized to organize and execute a formal felicitation ceremony for all students and team managers who participate at the university level. The University shall be responsible for bearing all associated costs of this ceremony, including the presentation of mementos.
11.2	Any matter not directly covered by these above all rules shall be decided by the Chairman, Sports Committee, in the light of the rules most nearly applicable and in accordance with the general spirit and intent of this policy. During the interpretation of these rules at any time, the decision of the Chairman, Sports Committee shall be final and binding to all.
