Genesis

ASPEE College of Horticulture is a prime institute providing Horticulture education and research in the state. This college was approved by Krushi and Gram Vikas Vibhag of the Government of Gujarat and started in November, 1988 at Navsari (Gujarat) and initially established with the name “ASPEE College of Horticulture and Forestry” with the vision to bring out trained human resource and research in two major field i.e. horticulture and forestry sectors. For starting this college, generous donation was provided by ASPEE Foundation for Agriculture and Development, Malad, Mumbai and therefore, the college derived its name as ‘ASPEE College of Horticulture and Forestry’.

With the formation of separate university on May 1, 2004, the college became an affiliated college of Navsari Agricultural University. In 2010 with the grant from Indian Council of Forestry research and Education (ICFRE), a separate college building was constructed and faculties of forestry recruited. The Horticulture college is a premier institute of the State catering to the demands of the region/state/nation and is accredited by Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi.

During May 2022, Forestry faculty gets separated from ‘ASPEE College of Horticulture and Forestry’ and two separate colleges have been formed for Horticulture and Forestry. During January 2023 the college renamed as ‘ASPEE College of Horticulture’.

ASPEE College of Horticulture provides ideal environment for teaching and research through well planned teaching facilities with well established buildings, research farms, state of art laboratories, library, reading room, conference/seminar halls and hostel.

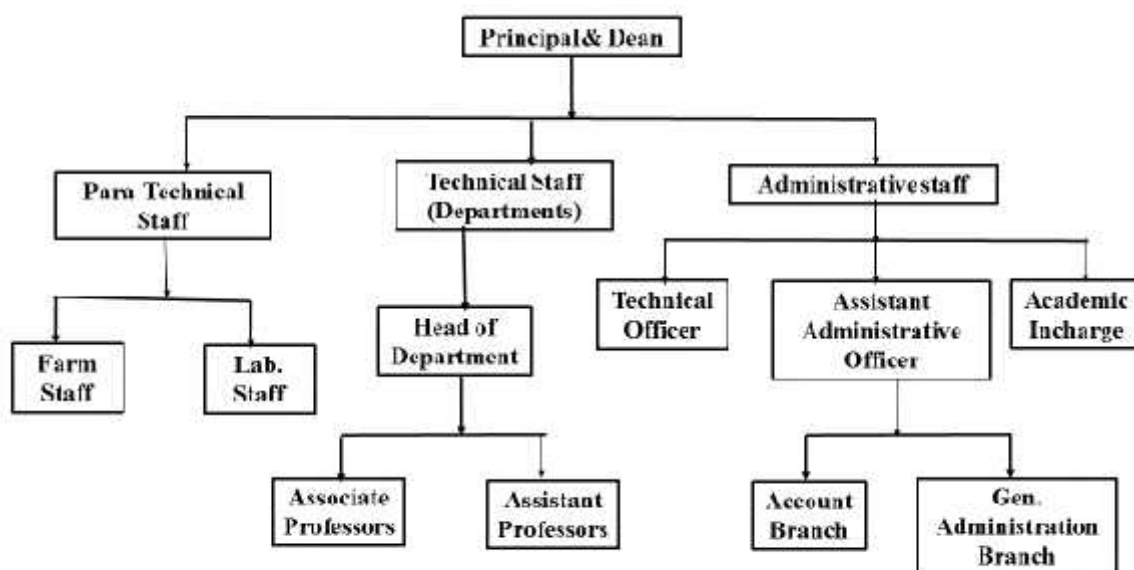
- ❖ To impart education and hands on training in the field of Horticulture leading to B.Sc., M.Sc. and Ph. D. degrees.

College Location



ASPEE College of Horticulture is located at the main campus of Navsari Agricultural University, Navsari (Gujarat) on the Dandi Heritage Route. The college is situated at a distance of 10 km away towards west side of NH 48 (Delhi- Mumbai). The nearest railway station is Navsari railway station of western railway at a distance of 2 km from the college. The nearest airport is Surat International Airport, Surat at a distance of 40 km and Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport, Mumbai at a distance of 240 km from the Navsari. The college is located at an elevation of 10 m above mean sea level. The great historical place Dandi, where the *Salt Satyagraha* of Mahatma Gandhi ends is located 15 km away towards west of the college.

Academic Programmes

This institute offers undergraduate and post graduate degree in the field of Horticulture

Under Graduate Degree Programme: B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture

B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture degree programme follows the ICAR Vth Deans' Committee recommendations and the programme is divided into eight semesters (4 years). The course curriculum has been dynamically aligned to the needs and aspirations of the horticulture based industry to ensure that students not just imbibe academic concepts but also gain practical expertise. Final year students of B.Sc. (Hons.) horticulture has to under go through the Experiential Learning Programme (ELP) during the 7th semester and Rural Horticultural Work Experience (RHWE) during the 8th semester of degree programme. (Total: 180 Credits)

Eligibility for UG admission

Candidtes who passed higher secondary with Physics, Chemistry and Biology with English are eligible for UG programme. The common state level admission notifications are notified in news papers as well as on website www.gsauca.in. Centralized online admission procedure on merit basis, for State Agricultural Universities (SAUs) of Gujarat is followed, considering weightage of marks obtained in 12th science stream (PCB) and GUJCET.

Post Graduate Programme

Post graduate programme in various disciplines of Horticulture was also started since its inception, 1997. The Post Graduate degrees are awarded on successful completion of course work and a dissertation based research work.

Eligibility for PG admission

For master's degree programme candidates should possess Bachelor degree {B.Sc.(Hons.) Horticulture/B.Sc.(Hons.) Agriculture} with an OGPA of not less than 6.00 (10.00 basis) or its equivalent in aggregate. For doctoral degree programme, candidate should possess Master Degree {M.Sc. (Horti.) in respective disciplines} with an OGPA of not less than 6.50 (10.00 basis) or its equivalent. The common state level admission notifications are notified in news papers as well as on website www.gsauca.in The admission is given on merit basis with the weightage of 50% marks obtained in entrance test and 50% marks of the last degree obtained.
