

PRIMARY HEALTH CENTRE



Primary Health Center (PHC) was established at Navsari Agricultural University in the year 1989 to provide basic health care facilities to the students, staff and farm laborers of the University. The PHC is committed to ensure the highest possible level of health and well-being, provide the basic needs of the university people starting from the promotion of health to prevention, treatment, rehabilitation and palliative care, as close as feasible to their day to day life and empowering them to take charge of their own health. A Doctor (MBBS) is being appointed to provide the preliminary treatment with the help of other technical staffs. The PHC has a well equipped laboratory to carry out the basic hematological, microscopical and biochemical test like HB, TC, DC, MP, WIDAL, ESR, lipid profile, renal function, liver function, diabetics, electrocardiogram (ECG) and X-Ray for routine checkup for initial diagnosis of any progressive disease. Medicinal kits were provided to students and staffs of university campus and sub centers for various educational tours throughout the year. Besides, the PHC in collaboration with the office of the DSW organized health, awareness and vaccination camp on various occasions.

During last five years (2017-2021) a total of 13346 patients were treated as OPD and laboratory facilities were utilized for confirmatory diagnosis of various diseases. In collaboration with the office of the DSW a vaccination drive was initiated amid COVID-19 pandemic and a total of 1004 doses of vaccine were given to the university staff and farm laborers in 2021.
