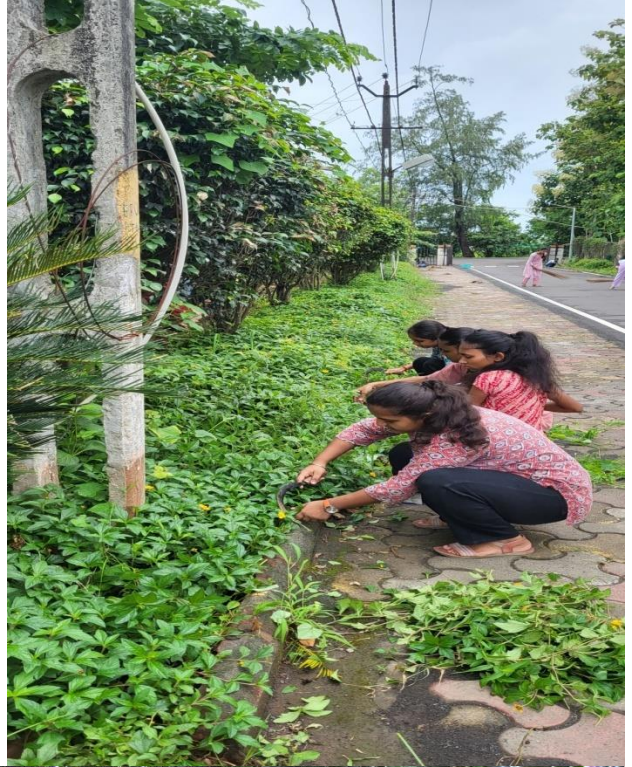




SAFAI ABHIYAN
