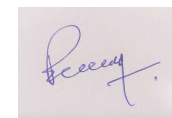

Guidelines for PG seminar series: Crop Protection Group
N. M. College of Agriculture, Navsari Agricultural University, Navsari

General:

- **All the students (Registered & Non- Registered)** are required to attend at least 75% of the seminar. If a student fails to attend 75% of the total number of seminar held during a semester, he/she shall repeat the seminar when offered in the next semester (As per common academic regulation 42.3; w.e.f. 01/07/2024).
- Presence of major guide is compulsory require to deliver a post graduate seminar of their student.
- All the committee members of PG student who is going to deliver his/her seminar must remain present in the session. In case of unavailability of any member, the major guide must obtain prior written permission from Principal and Dean through concerned coordinator of group by opting other faculty member.
- All the faculty members of N. M. College of Agriculture, Navsari, must attend the PG seminars. Moreover, PG guides/teachers from NAU main campus (Other than NMCA) are expected to attend at least 50 per cent of seminar sessions during the series.
- A minimum of five evaluators/examiners shall be mandatory for the evaluation of a postgraduate seminar.

Preparation of Seminar Script (Gist):

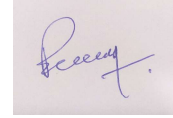
- Prepare Seminar Script (Gist) within two pages (i.e. Single A4 page) only in Times New Roman with minimum font size 11. Distribute script in the beginning of the presentation to all the available faculty members as well as P.G. students.
- Carefully proof your script for spelling mistakes and grammatical errors before final print. More than four mistakes in spelling/typing/grammar will not be allowed in the script. References should be quoted strictly in alphabetical orders.
- Research work pertaining to seminar topic under Gujarat condition must be included in the seminar, if it is available.
- There is no necessity of giving sub titles/sub-headings in the script.
- **References should be written as per following format,**
Mehta, K. C. (1933) *Ind. J. Agric. Sci.*, **3**: 939.

Power Point Presentation:

While addressing to the audience, the seminar speaker should introduce him/her self and give brief account of UG/PG studies and regarding research work, if started.

- Give introduction and conclusion of the seminar without the help of any visual aids.
- Present the information in bullet form, not in complete sentences. Include 4-5 points per slide.
- Avoid wordiness: use key words and phrases only.
- Concentrate towards audience on what you are saying.
- Do not use distracting animations and do not go for overboard with the animations.
- Use different font size e.g. Title 36, text 28 and subsequent 24. Minimum font size will be 18. Use a regular font like Times New Roman or Arial. Don't use complicated fonts.
- Use a colour of font that contrasts sharply with the background. e.g. blue font on white background. Use only 2 to 3 colors for different points, if necessary.
- Use the same background consistently throughout your presentation.
- Proof your slides for technical error, spelling mistakes and grammatical errors.
- Give readable numbers to all the slides of your presentation on the bottom at right corner is mandatory.

- Conclude your presentation by considering quoted references only i.e. generalized conclusion/statement will not be accepted.
- Provide the source at the bottom of concern slide: If e-source or printed source is not mentioned in the gist. Mention the courtesy for the slides/photographs, if applicable.
