Department of Wildlife Sciences College of Forestry Navsari Agricultural University Navsari 396 450 Gujarat Certificate Course in Nature and Wildlife Photography (CCNWP) started in 2013. The course is for anyone interested to learn about photography.

Course is structured into 3 distinct parts

- 1. Understanding the camera, which involves learning essential concepts like adjusting settings, controlling focus, using various lenses and comprehending how the camera captures light. In simple terms, it's like getting to know your camera inside and out so that you can take better photos.
- 2. The art of seeing and making of images, the creative and artistic aspects of photography. It's not just about operating a camera but also about how you perceive the world around you and translate that into compelling images.
- 3. Post-processing, the visual impact involves the art of refining and improving photographs after they've been captured. It's a crucial step to make images visually appealing and suitable for specific purposes. In this process, various tools and techniques are used to bring out the full potential of a photograph.



Duration of course is one year from January to December 2025; the classes are conducted once in a week- every Saturday for 2 hours. Total 45 sessions and field trips.

Each session is of 2 hours: One hour in theory class, another is practical which is in the field or on computer.

Intake is 10 students each year.

Eligibility is above 18 years. Preference is given to those who have prior experience and interest in photography. The course is open to all walks of life, from diverse professional backgrounds and age groups.

Course Fee is INR 25,000 for all Photography Enthusiasts, and INR 20,000 for bona fide students of school, college or university.

Components of the Course are...

Regular Classes: Every Saturday for 2 hours

- Flickr uploads: Students upload their weekly work to course's Flickr page to facilitate sharing of their images with peers and instructors. This process allows guidance and growth by enabling students to learn from one another.
- Critique: By submitting five images per week, students actively engage with honing photography skills. This enables us to provide timely and relevant feedback. We can identify strengths and areas for improvement in each student's work.
- Field Trips: Practical assignments are given during 3 days field trips, which serve to sharpen photography skills and apply what they've learned in the classroom.
- Evaluation: We assess students on 4 modules, namely Regular Photo Upload on NAU Flickr Account, Assignments During Field Trips, Written Examination and Post-Processing Examination, each of 25 marks.

Certification: Student who secures 50% marks in all 4 modules receives Certificate.

Medals: Top 3 students of each batch are awarded gold, silver and bronze medals.

Passing Out Exhibition: The culmination of course is a grand event - an annual exhibition that not only celebrates students' outstanding work but also imparting platform to present their skills developed in a year.
