In exercise of the power vested in Section 22(2)(xiv and xv) of the Gujarat Agricultural Universities Act, 2004 (Gujarat Act No. 5 of 2004) the Academic Council may approve following Regulations governing Games, Sports Tournaments, Cultural, Literary Competitions and Adventure Activities for Inter-college/ Inter-polytechnic/ Inter University "of the State Agricultural Universities and recommend to be approved by the Academic Council

<b>1.</b>	<b>"Regulations governing Games, Sports, Cultural, Literary Competition / Tournaments and Adventure Activities of the Navsari Agricultural University "</b>	<b>Title of the Rules</b>
<b>1.1</b>	These rules shall be called "Regulations governing Games, Sports Tournaments, Cultural, Literary Competition and Adventure Activities for Inter-college / Inter-polytechnic / Inter -university " of the Navsari Agricultural University.	
<b>1.2</b>	They shall come into force with immediate effect.	
<b>2.</b>	In these rules, unless the context otherwise require,	<b>Definition</b>
<b>2.1</b>	<b>SPORTS</b> means an activity that is governed by a set of rules or customs and often engaged in competitively. Sports commonly refers to activities where the physical capabilities of the competitor are the sole or primary determinant of the outcome (winning or losing), but the term is also used to include activities such as mind sports and motor sports where mental acuity or equipment quality are major factors. Sport is commonly defined as an organized, competitive and skillful physical activity requiring commitment and fair play.	
<b>2.2</b>	<b>PLAYER/PARTICIPANT</b> means one that plays/performs, especially one who participates in Games, Sports Tournaments, Cultural, Literary Competition and Adventure Activities of the State Agricultural University.	
<b>2.3</b>	<b>TOURNAMENT</b> means a sporting competition in which contestants play a series of games to determine an overall winner.	
<b>2.4</b>	<b>INTER-COLLEGIATE</b> means competition taking place among different colleges (degree and polytechnic) of the university of the state.	
<b>2.5</b>	<b>INTER-UNIVERSITY</b> means competition taking place among different Universities of the state or the country.	
<b>2.6</b>	<b>COLLEGE</b> means a constituent college conducting degree or polytechnic programme in the state Agricultural Universities.	
<b>2.7</b>	<b>SPORTS COMMITTEE</b> means a committee of the Student Sports and Recreation. The Committee has to develop and implement strategies and policies to develop, encourage and coordinate sports activities across the institute.	
<b>2.8</b>	<b>REFEREE/ JUDGE</b> means a person who has authority to make decisions about play/performances in many sports/competitions.	
<b>2.9</b>	<b>COMPETITION</b> means an official participation in organized sport.	
<b>2.10</b>	<b>TEAM</b> means a number of persons associated together in any sports; especially, a number of persons selected to contend on one side in a match, or a series of matches.	

3.	There shall be a committee consisting of the following to organize, control, manage and supervise various competitions/tournaments and students' welfare programme within the jurisdiction of the university and conduct inter-university sports tournament/competition.	<b>Sports Committee</b>
	i. Director of Students' Welfare-Chairman	
	ii. Chairman of the Students' Representative Council of all the constituent Colleges -Member	
	iii. Physical Instructors of all the constituent Colleges -Member	
4.	<b>The powers and functions of the sports committee shall be as follows:</b>	<b>Power/ Functions of the Sports Committee</b>
	i. To prepare its programme calendar, various games, sports, cultural and literary events, adventure programmes and its budget for presentation to the University.	
	ii. To decide University should participate in the several inter-university games and sports competitions.	
	iii. To appoint sub-committee if necessary, to select university team and to conduct inter-university games and sports competitions whenever the University is asked to do so by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), Inter Agricultural Universities Association (IAUA) or Council of State Agricultural Universities of Gujarat.	
	iv. To frame eligibility rules and general rules for sports and games, debate, extempore, essay, cultural competitions and other adventure programmes.	
	v. To settle dispute if any, among constituent colleges with regard to tournaments / competitions and other student activities within the jurisdiction of the sports committee.	
	vi. To take up such other programmes and activities within the jurisdiction of the sports committee as desired for the welfare of the students.	
5.	<b>Inter-collegiate / Inter-polytechnic Sports and Games Tournaments/ Competitions</b>	<b>Inter-collegiate / Inter-polytechnic Sports and Games Tournaments/ Competitions</b>
5.1	The method of the various tournaments / competitions shall be decided by the Committee.	
5.2	All the colleges/polytechnics shall inform the organizing college/polytechnic regarding their participation and shall submit the eligibility pro forma of the players before the commencement of the tournaments / competitions.	
5.3	A lots of the tournaments / competitions will be drawn in presence of all team managers and organizing secretary.	
5.4	The Sports Committee shall allocate the responsibility to conduct the tournament / competition to any constituent college.	
5.5	The organizing college/polytechnic shall be responsible for its organization, supervision and conduct of the tournament / competition for this purpose. If required, the Principal of the organizing college/polytechnic shall appoint various committees. The Chairman, Students' Representative Council shall be the organizing secretary. However, the overall responsibility of organizing the tournament / competition shall be of the Director of Students' Welfare and he/she may delegate his/her power to anyone to whom he/she deems fit wishes to. The organizing secretary shall draw the detailed programme of the	

	inter-college/polytechnic tournament / competition and send it to all participating colleges/polytechnics under intimation to the chairman, sports committee.																																											
<b>5.6</b>	It shall be the duty of organizing committee to ensure that all the rules and regulations laid down by the sports committee for the inter-college/polytechnic tournaments /competitions are fully observed and game/tournament/competition is played fairly. In case, where a particular team has included ineligible player, as defined in the rules, the team shall be disqualified from the tournament after due verification. In case of the misconduct by any individual player(s) or a team as a whole, the organizing committee shall have power even to scratch the team/disqualify the individual player(s) from the tournament/competition. While doing so, whoever, the organizing committee shall strictly follow the procedure as laid down below:																																											
	<p>(a) Both the teams under dispute are given full opportunities to explain their respective points of view.</p> <p>(b) The Principal of the organizing college/polytechnic shall constitute committee of</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(1) Organizing Secretary</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(2) Physical Instructor</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(3) One expert of the game</p> <p>(c) The matter is reported immediately to the Chairman, Sports Committee for information and further action if any.</p>																																											
<b>5.7</b>	The Organizing Secretary and Physical Instructor in consultation shall be empowered to select/appoint the competent referee/ official/judge for the tournament/competition.																																											
<b>5.8</b>	It shall be duty of the Organizing Secretary to inform the Chairman, Sports Committee regarding the date of tournament/competition. The result of the tournament/competition along with eligibility pro forma and list of the selected players of the university team shall be submitted to the Chairman, Sports Committee. Also to communicate the result to all the colleges on the next day.																																											
<b>5.9</b>	Each constituent college/polytechnic shall be entitled to send only one team for each tournament/competition.

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	(i) Sports committee is empowered to add or delete any game/sport/event and number of participants.	
	(b) If less than three teams are participating in the team event tournament/competition, the same tournament/competition shall not be organized. (c) In individual event like Athletic, if there are less than three competitors, the competition of that event shall not be organized.	
<b>5.11</b>	There shall be no entry fees for participation in inter college/polytechnic tournaments/competitions.	
<b>5.12</b>	Each college/polytechnic entering a tournament/competition shall supply necessary information prescribed by the Sports Committee to the Organizing Secretary.	
<b>5.13</b>	Eligibility rules for participants (a) As per rules prescribed by the AIU/IAUA/ICAR from time to time. (b) A student shall not compete on behalf of more than one college/polytechnic in any Inter-Collegiate/Inter-Polytechnic tournaments/competition in a year.	
<b>5.14</b>	(a) In Athletics, no student can participate in more than five events excluding relay races for Individual General Championship. (b) Men Player should have taken part in any 5 events (2 running events and 3 field events or 3 running events and 2 field events, relay shall not be considered). (c) Women Player should have taken part in any 3 events (2 running event and 1 field event or 1 running event and 2 field events, relay shall not be considered). (d) There shall be a separate general Championship for Men and Women players of the University. (e) Minimum 3 players shall take part in the Individual General Championship. (f) Following Athletic events shall be played for Inter Collegiate Athletic competition: <u>Athletics (Inter-Collegiate)</u> (i) <u>Men</u> : 100mts, 200mts, 400mts, 800mts, 1500mts, 5000mts, 4x100 Relay, Shot-put, Discuss Throw, Javelin Throw, Long Jump, High Jump, Triple Jump (ii) <u>Women</u> : 100mts, 200mts, 400mts, 800mts, 4x100Relay, Shot-put, Discuss Throw, Javelin Throw, Long Jump, High Jump, Triple Jump  <u>Athletics (Inter-Polytechnic)</u> (i) <u>Men</u> : 100mts, 200mts, 400mts, 4x100Relay, Shot-put, Discuss Throw, Javelin Throw, Long Jump, High Jump, Triple Jump (ii) <u>Women</u> : 100mts, 200mts, 400mts, 4x100Relay, Shot-put, Discuss Throw, Long Jump, High Jump, Triple Jump <b>Note:</b> The Sports Committee is empowered to delete or add any Athletic events for men and women.	

5.15	All Athletes and competitors participating in Inter-college/polytechnic tournaments/competitions shall carry with them identity cards signed by the Principal of the college concerned.

5.17	If the match is not played due to any sound reasons like rain etc., it shall be played as per the rules of a particular game.																
5.18	Protest against the decision of referee/umpire/judge or any other matter shall be lodged in writing within two hours of conclusion of the game/competition and depositing Rs.2000/- to the person in charge of the organizing college/polytechnic.																
5.19	If the protest is lodged prior to or during match, the match shall be played out. Teams, which abandon a match for any reason, shall be considered to have concerned it. Any team leaving field of play under protest shall be deemed to have loss the fixture and forfeited whenever a protest is not sustained. The Organizing Secretary shall send a report of any such incident to the Chairman, Sports Committee.																
5.20	<p>i. The Organizing College shall arrange for the trophies either from its own funds or from donation and those shall be the property of the winner/runners up college.</p> <p>ii. Trophies shall be awarded to the Winner and Runners up Colleges.</p>																
5.21	A certificate of merit shall be awarded to all the players of the winning team in team games/competitions securing First and Second places. In solo game/sports certificate of merit shall be awarded to First, Second and Third position holder.																
5.22	<p>i. There shall be an Overall General Championship Trophy which shall be awarded to the college obtaining the highest aggregate points won on basis of the scoring system given below in Team Games, Athletics and Cultural Competitions.</p> <p>ii. 5.23	The Annual Athletic Meet shall be the last function of the inter-college/polytechnic tournament of the year, wherein award of trophies, prizes, medals, certificates <i>etc.</i> shall made to individual winners and winning teams. The captains of winning teams of different games shall remain present to receive prizes, trophies <i>etc.</i> For this purpose, the captain of winning team is entitled for TA/DA as per the rules.	
5.24	<p>i. Expenses on account of refreshment, official charges, ground preparation hiring of grounds and such other items pertaining to pay-fields shall be borne by the University as per the budget provision.</p> <p>ii. The University shall bear total cost of the second class rail/bus fare with reservation charges of players other than local players from the place of the college/polytechnic to the place of tournament and back, if transportation arrangement is made by the college/polytechnic, the university shall bear the total diesel/ oil expenditure.</p> <p>iii. The University shall bear total cost of the D.A. of student participants.</p> <p>(i) Student participants of out-station college/polytechnic shall be paid D.A. at the rate of Rs.175/-per day each.</p> <p>(ii) Student participants of local college/polytechnic shall be paid the refreshment/convenience allowance at the rate of Rs.100/- per day.</p> <p>If the tournament is conducted during the vacation, the participating players are entitled to get full D.A. and T.A. from the place of native to the place of tournament and back at the rate shown in (i) and (ii) earlier.</p> <p>iv. The university shall bear the expenses (Honorarium/Remuneration/T.A/D.A) on account of the allowances to the official of the tournament as under:</p> <p>(i) Honorarium/Remuneration to the officials of various tournaments shall be paid as per Appendix-I</p>	
5.25	The university shall bear the cost of Rs. 600/- per participant as dress allowance for each inter-collegiate / inter-polytechnic tournament / competition.	

<b>6.</b>	<b>Inter- collegiate Debate Competition</b>	<b>Inter- collegiate Debate Competition</b>
<b>6.1</b>	Any student enrolled in the constituent college of the university shall be eligible to participate in this competition. The eligibility rules for the competition shall be same as the rules for the Sports and Games.	
<b>6.2</b>	Each college shall send maximum four competitors, out of these, two competitors shall speak in favor and other two shall speak against the topic.	
<b>6.3</b>	The organizing college is empowered to decide the topic for the competition.	
<b>6.4</b>	The participating students should be given five minutes to speak on the topic.	
<b>6.5</b>	Participant shall speak either in English, Hindi or Gujarati.	
<b>6.6</b>	The expenditure for organizing the competition such as refreshment, officiating charges, prizes <i>etc</i> shall be paid from the university fund allotted for the purpose.	
<b>6.7</b>	Participants of different colleges shall be entitled to get T.A. and D.A. as decided for the inter-collegiate Sports and Games Tournaments.	
<b>6.8</b>	The judges for the competition shall be appointed by the organizing college and they are entitled to get T.A. and D.A. as per the inter-college Sports and Game Tournaments and shall be paid honorarium for this assignment as per the rates mentioned in the Appendix-I.	
<b>6.9</b>	The decision of the judging committee shall be final.	
<b>6.10</b>	Overall aggregate total score of judging committee shall be considered to find out the winners.	
<b>7.</b>	<b>Inter- Collegiate Extempore Competition</b>	<b>Inter- Collegiate Extempore Competition</b>
<b>7.1</b>	Any student enrolled in the constituent college of the university shall be eligible to participate in this competition. The eligibility rules for the competition shall be same as the rules for the Sports and Games.	
<b>7.2</b>	Each college shall send maximum two competitors to participate in the competition.	
<b>7.3</b>	The organizing college is empowered to decide the topic for the competition.	
<b>7.4</b>	The participating students should be given five minutes to speak on the topic.	
<b>7.5</b>	Participant shall speak either in English, Hindi or Gujarati.	
<b>7.6</b>	The expenditure for organizing the competition such as refreshment, officiating charges, prizes <i>etc</i> shall be paid from the university fund as allotted for this purpose.	
<b>7.7</b>	Participants of different colleges shall be entitled to get T.A. and D.A. as decided for the Inter-College Sports and Games tournaments.	
<b>7.8</b>	The judges for the competition shall be appointed by the organizing college and they are entitled to get T.A. and D.A. as per the Inter College Sports and Games tournament and shall be paid honorarium for	

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<b>8.</b>	<b>Inter-Collegiate Cultural Competition</b>	<b>Inter-Collegiate Cultural Competition</b>																																												
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<b>8.2</b>	There shall be separate competitions for Patriotic Group Song, Folk Dance, Folk Song, Drama (One Act Play), Mime and Mono Acting.																																													
<b>8.3</b>	Each college shall send one entry for Drama (One Act Play), Patriotic Group Song, Folk Dance and Mime and two entries for Mono-Acting and Folk Song.																																													
<b>8.4</b>	Total number of participants from a college shall not be more than 30 for Literary and Cultural Competitions excluding accompanists.																																													
<b>8.5</b>	The duration of various competitions is as follow: Drama - 30 minutes Mono Acting - 5 minutes each Mime – 5 minutes Folk Dance - 10 minutes Patriotic Group Song – 6 minutes Folk Song - 6 minutes																																													
<b>8.6</b>	Participating college shall submit the details of all entries to the organizing college before 5 days.																																													
<b>8.7</b>	General guidelines regarding all events shall be as decided by the Sports Committee which is also empowered to add or delete any event and number of participants.																																													
<b>8.8</b>	The organizing college shall appoint the judging committee of two/three members. The aggregate / total score of the committee shall be considered to find out the individual winner and winning college for each event separately.																																													
<b>8.9</b>	The decision of judging committee shall be final and binding to all.																																													
<b>8.10</b>	A certificate to every winner and trophy to winning college shall be awarded as under:

<b>8.12</b>	Expenses on account of refreshment, official charges, stage preparation, dress on rent and such other items pertaining to tournament shall be borne by the University.					
<b>8.13</b>	Each member of judging committee shall be paid T.A. and D.A. as per the rules of inter-collegiate Sports and Games tournaments and an honorarium as per the rates mentioned in the Appendix-I.

<b>9.1</b>	The University may participate in the Inter-University tournaments / competitions/YuvaMahotsav/ KhelMaahakumbh / West Zone & AIU tournaments etc. as may be decided by the Sports Committee.					
<b>9.2</b>	The selection of the university team or participants shall be made on the basis of performance in the inter-collegiate tournaments/competitions.					
<b>9.3</b>	The selection committee for the selection of university team shall be as under : (i) Physical Instructor/s (ii) Chief Referees If the teams/participants are not selected by selection committee, the Chairman, Sports Committee is empowered to select the same to represent the university.					
<b>9.4</b>	The Chairman, Sports Committee may assign any staff member as team manager who will be overall responsible for the participation in the tournament/competition.					
<b>9.5</b>	The annual subscription for the membership of the concerned association shall be paid by the university every year.					
<b>9.6</b>	The University shall bear the cost of Rs. 800/- per participant as dress allowance for each tournament/competition.					
<b>9.7</b>	(i) The university shall bear the expenditure for track-suit of maximum cost of Rs. 2500/- for all the participants. The track – suit shall be given to the player only once in one degree programme at the university. (ii) The university shall bear the expenditure for track-suit of maximum cost of Rs. 2500/- for the Team Manager with an interval of 3 years.					
<b>9.8</b>	The university shall bear the second class railway fare with reservation/state or private bus traveling charges or the diesel, oil, R.T.O/toll taxes, expenses of the university vehicles.					

<b>9.9</b>	(i) An amount of Rs. 350/- will be paid as DA inclusive of Refreshment Allowances and no separate refreshment charges will be paid to the players. These rates will be applicable in respect of all cities. (ii) Local participants will be paid Rs. 200/- as refreshment allowances.	
<b>9.10</b>	The university will provide T.A. and D.A. to the player/participant for coaching camp at the rates of the rules of the inter-collegiate/inter-polytechnic tournament/competition.	
<b>9.11</b>	The university shall provide the equipment, ground facility <i>etc.</i> required for coaching camp.	
<b>9.12</b>	The university shall bear the cost of officiating charges, equipment charges or other charges of the tournaments/competitions.	
<b>9.13</b>	University may appoint a coach for advance training to the university team. He / She shall be entitled to get T.A. and D.A. as well as Honorarium as per rules for the officials of inter-collegiate/inter-polytechnic tournament/competition.	
<b>9.14</b>	Petty expenditure for refreshing item such as glucose, lemon, ice-cream, biscuit, fruit <i>etc.</i> will be borne by the university.	
<b>9.15</b>	In case of sickness or physical injury to the player/participant during the actual game/competition/coaching camp at the time of inter-college/inter-polytechnic and inter-university/All India competition, the cost of medical treatment of the player/participant shall be borne by the University.	
<b>9.16</b>	Any point not directly covered by these rules shall be decided by the Sports Committee in the light of the rules most nearly applicable and in the accordance with the general tenor /tendency and spirit of the said rules. During the interpretation of the same rules at any time, the decision of the Director of Students' Welfare shall be final.

### **Traveling Allowances/ other expenses for Referee/Judge/Assistant official:**

- (a) Maximum II-tier AC railway fare or actual fare shall be paid from their Native/Office to the place of tournament and back, if arrangements for transport are not made by university.
- (b) If travel made by own vehicle the T.A. shall be paid as per Navsari Agricultural University.
- (c) Rs. 250/- per day as D.A. for outsider Referee / Judge officials and Rs. 175/- per day for outsider Assistant official.
- (d) Rs. 175/- per day shall be paid as D.A. and convenience allowance to the Referee / Judge officials and Rs. 150/- to local Assistant official.
