














LOGO DESCRIPTION

The logo of College of Forestry symbolizes the holistic growth, development, protection, conservation, sustainable management and utilization of forest ecosystems through Education, Research and Extension.

The logo composed of earth, sun, tree, wildlife, book, pen nib and convocation cap, which symbolizes the educational components.



	The circle represents the mother earth which depicts our philosophy of one earth one family one future. It also ignites our core belief of “ <i>Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam</i> ”.
	There are 33 cones in the outer circle of the logo and represent the need of 33 % area under forests globally for healthy functioning of ecosystems as per the WHO recommendations. They also depict 33 districts of Gujarat, which cover different forest types, being the only one Forestry College in the state, covers all the districts of Gujarat as its jurisdiction. In fact, these 33 cones would epitomize the shining glory of the forestry fraternity. The yellow colour filled in the cones represents global energy regulatory services of forest ecosystems and hope to increase the global forests.
	Sun is the supreme source of light and energy for the mother nature and it symbolize the enlightenment.
	The tree symbolizes the life and represents various forms of vegetation in different ecosystems comprising biodiversity on earth.

	The five prominent branches represent harmony between five elements of nature (<i>Panchmahabhut</i>) viz., earth, water, air, fire and space. It also indicates overall health, strength, knowledge, wisdom and prosperity. Apparently, it also symbolises five departments of the college.
	Green leaves express the self-sustenance, biomass accumulation and nutrient dynamics. They also symbolise peace and spiritual wellbeing. There are 63 leaves in the logo - 8 light green leaves, symbolizes the agroclimatic zones of Gujarat and 55 dark green leaves symbolizes 25 forest types, 4 national parks, 23 wildlife sanctuaries, and 3 other protected areas (1 each biosphere, conservation, grassland reserves).
	Tiger pugmark recognises strength, courage, nationality and prosperity of different forms of wildlife present in various ecosystems.
	The feather of national bird Peafowl symbolizes the blessings of “ <i>Maa Saraswati</i> ” the goddess of knowledge, learning and wisdom.
	Book signifies the ancestral as well as modern treasure of information, knowledge and learning.
	A pen nib sculpts the student's skills, creativity, literary development, legacy and an art of communication. The convocation cap represents the empowerment of youth through formal education, innovative research and dissemination of learnt knowledge for sustenance of forests.
