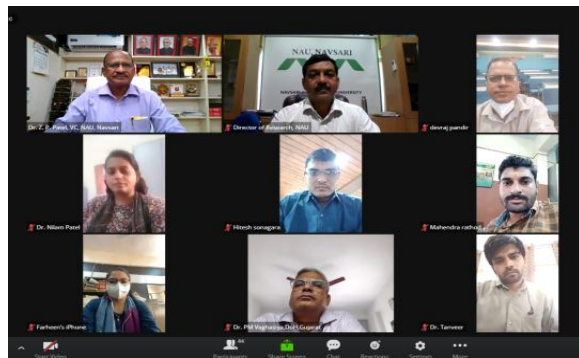

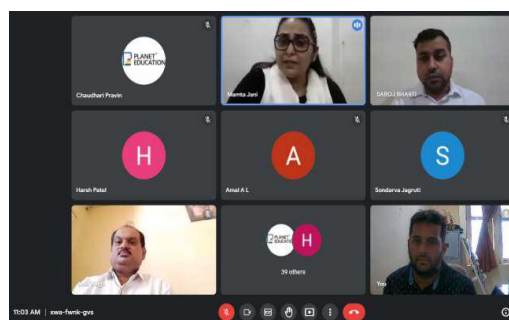
Workshop on Opportunities for Innovation and Entrepreneurship in Agriculture

Training on Vegetable Grafting: Concepts and Applications



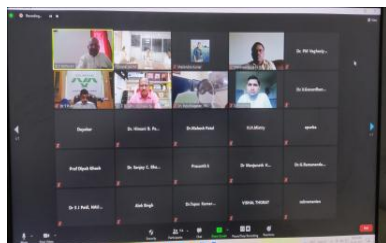

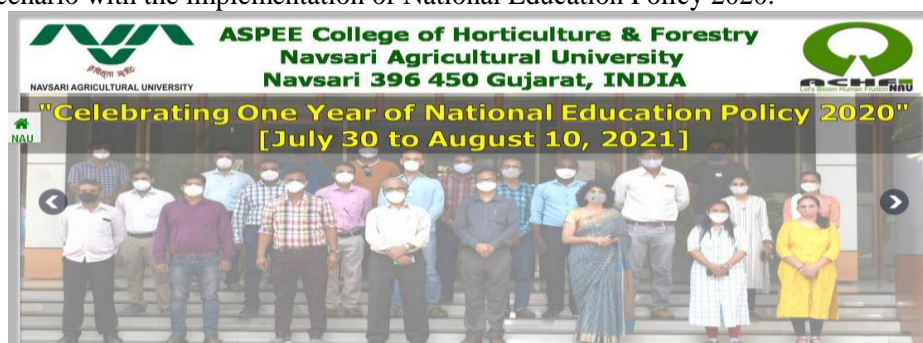
