For the UG, PG and Ph.D. Students

Topic:

- Language: English/ Gujarati/ Hindi
- **Duration:** Maximum 5 minutes per participant (Warning bell after 4 minutes)
- Participants: One pair (Two participants) from each college can participate. There have to be **two participants**: **one speaking in favor and the other speaking against** the motion. Each participant of the pair can speak in the language of his/her choice (i.e. English/Hindi/Gujarati).
- NOTE: The aggregate performance of the pair will be judged. Individual performance will not be taken into account.
- Two best pairs and one best individual debater will be appreciated by the university. Rest will get a participation certificate.
- Participant students will have to report at the venue of the competition at 9:00 hrs sharp.
- The decision of judges will be final.

General rules for competition

Quiz Competition

- Separate competitions will be organized for the polytechnic level as well as degree college level.
- A team of three participants can participate from each college/polytechnic.
- Subjects/Area: General Knowledge/Awareness (25%), Current Affairs (25%), General/Basic Agriculture (25%) and Constitution of India (25%)
- First round (for Degree College only): Each team will be given a set of 60 questions to solve in 30 minutes. Best Five teams will be selected for the On the Stage Ouiz Competition.
- For polytechnic level participants there will be a direct quiz competition.
- On the stage quiz competition shall have Three Rounds: 1. Oral questions, 2. Audio Visual Round, 3. Fastest Finger First Round.
- Rules for the on-the-stage competition will be explained at the start of the competition.
- Best Three Teams will be awarded by the university. Rest will get a participation certificate.
- The team will have to report at the competition venue on or before 9:00 hrs on the day of the competition i.e. 26/04/2024.
- Venue: Central Examination Hall, NAU, Navsari
