# RULES AND REGULATION FOR INTER COLLEGIATE CULTURAL COMPETITION GUNJAN 2024-25

- (A) As per minutes of the meeting held on August 6, 2024 in the office of Director, Students' Welfare, NAU, Navsari, it was decided that in the Intercollegiate Cultural Competition
  - The item presented by a participating college shall not be repeated for consecutive subsequent two years.
  - The item which had received first place during previous year must not repeated by winner college for subsequent three years. Other college can perform it if they want to.
- **(B)** Best Actor and Best Actress points will not be considered for overall championship
- (C) Total No. of Participants: (Maximum: 34) as per minutes of meeting dt. (06/08/2024)

(**D**) Scoring of Intercollegiate Literary and Cultural competition overall championship

**(E)** Event wise rules & regulations are as below:

## A. MIME

- Only one team per college is allowed.
- Maximum number of participants shall be six and accompanists shall be only one.
- The costume shall be only BLACK, gloves and socks shall be white, lips and eyes may be RED, if required.
- Maximum time allotted for each team shall be 5 minutes.
- No team shall announce the theme.
- No light adjustment is allowed. Only flood lights to be used.
- Both recorded and live music is allowed.
- Decision of the judge shall be final and binding upon all.

## **B. ONE ACT PLAY (DRAMA)**

- Only one team per college is allowed.
- Plays with themes related to rural, agricultural, social, cultural backgrounds only are admitted.
- The duration of the play shall not exceed 30 minutes.

- Time shall be counted as soon as the "Start" signal is given.
- For stage setting up to 10 minutes and removal of set and properties etc. up to 5 minutes shall be given after taking charge of the stage.
- Empty stage to empty stage shall be strictly followed.
- Maximum number of participants shall be 10 and accompanists shall not exceed
   5.
- Maximum number of participants + accompanists shall be 13.
- The play may be in Gujarati, English, or Hindi language.
- No separate time shall be provided for reading the synopsis.
- The synopsis shall be read by the host college.
- Participating team shall bring its own sets, stage properties, makeup materials, etc.
- Participating team shall report to the official in-charge of the competition at least 1/2 hrs before the presentation of the play.
- Judgment will be based on qualities like theme, acting, stage craft, design and general impression.
- Background recorded music is allowed.
- Decision of the judge shall be final and binding upon all.

#### C. MONO ACTING

- Each college shall be represented by **one participant**.
- The theme of mono acting will be open for your choice.
- Duration shall not be exceeding 5 minutes.
- Judgment will be based on qualities like acting and creativity, script, subject matter and overall impression.
- Decision of the judge shall be final and binding upon all.

## D. FOLK DANCE

- Only one team per college is allowed.
- Maximum number of participants per team is 10.
- The team may consist of all boys, all girls or a mixture of both.
- Maximum number of accompanists is 5.
- Maximum number of participants + accompanists shall be 13.
- Duration of Group Dance shall not be more than 10 minutes.
- Participating team shall be responsible for removal of their sets, stage props and properties etc. immediately after the completion of their performance.

- Separate time of 2 minutes shall be allotted for reading the synopsis outside the specified time.
- Either pre recorder or live music is allowed.
- Decision of the judge shall be final and binding upon all.

#### E. DEBATE

- Each college shall be represented by two participants only-one speaking in favour and one speaking against.
- Each participating student shall be given 5 minutes to speak on the topic.
- Gujarati, Hindi, or English language can be used as medium of expression.
- There will be a warning bell at four minute. The candidate has to conclude his/her speech in remaining one minute.
- Decision of the judge shall be final and binding upon all.

## F. ELOCUTION

- Only one participant per college is allowed.
- Each participating student shall be given 5 minutes to speak on the topic. Gujarati, Hindi, or English language can be used as medium of expression.
- There will be a warning bell at four minute. The candidate has to conclude his/her speech in remaining one minute.
- Decision of the judge shall be final and binding upon all.

## G. EXTEMPORE SPEECH

- Only one participant per college is allowed.
- The topic shall be given on the spot.
- Each participating student shall be given 5 minutes to speak on the topic. Gujarati, Hindi, or English language can be used as medium of expression.
- There will be a warning bell at four minute. The candidate has to conclude his/her speech in remaining one minute.
- Decision of the judge shall be final and binding upon all.

Note: Total No. of participants shall not exceed 34
